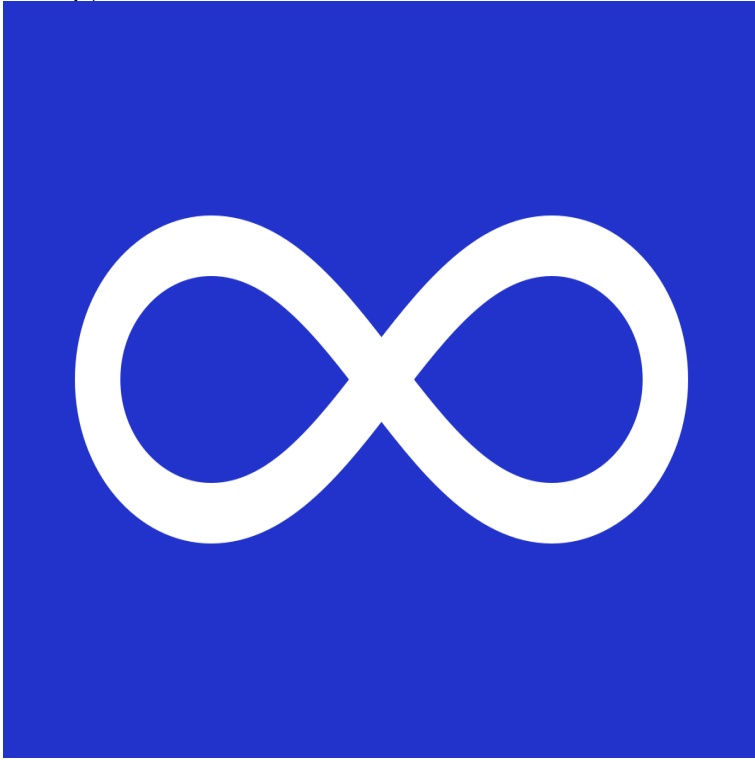


Flags Of The Metis
